# RIVER AUTHORITIES

First authorized by the legislature in 1917, river authorities are assigned the conservation and restoration of the state's natural resources, including the development and management of water. They generally operate to efficiently manage available water resources, including water treatment and other necessary services. TRWC recognizes 16 river authorities in Texas along with other special law districts authorized by the legislature. (2017 State Year Book)
